Facilitators are responsible for creating and teaching a 50-minute activity. This is a potent role to hold, as you will be affecting the children in deep ways through the activity offered and the space in which it is held. The activities are intended to support the children in self-inquiry and creative expression. Each class is taught a total of three times – once for each group of 15 children (45 children at Camp, ages 5-11) – so it is possible to offer a different activity each day.
